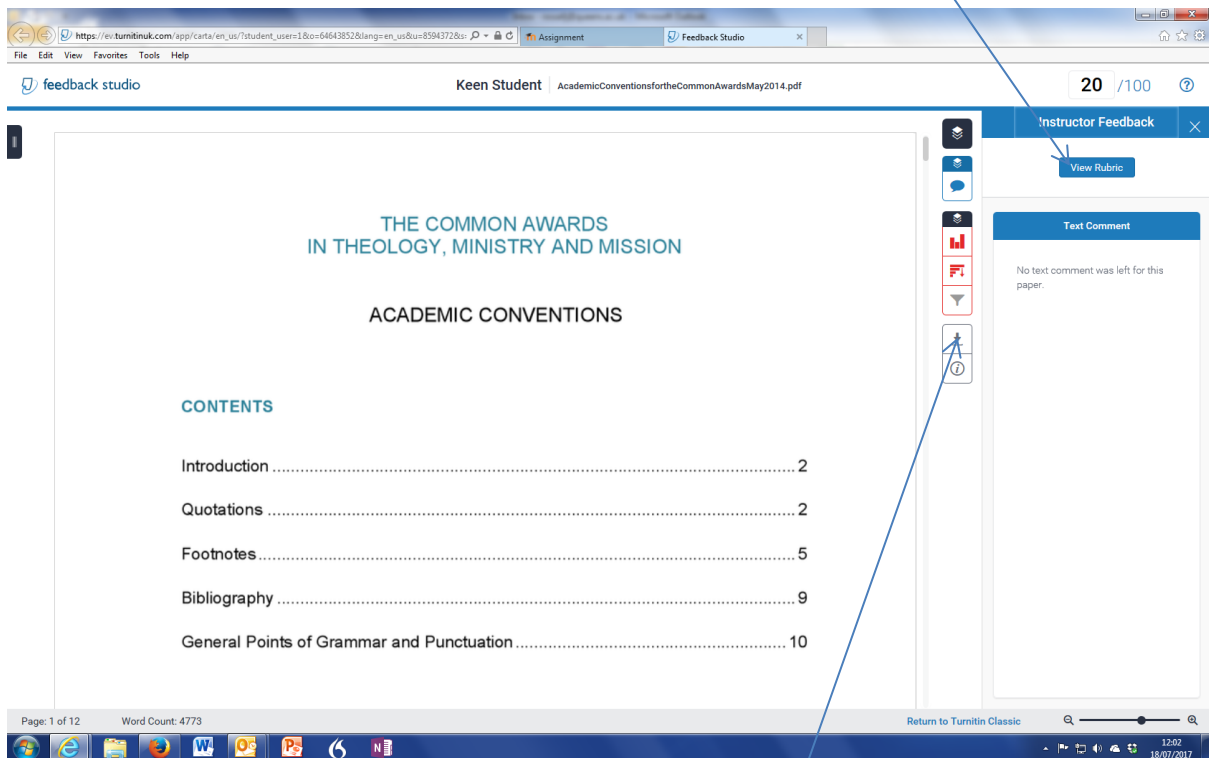


Turnitin Studio
