The World Communion of Reformed Churches (WCRC), in association with Lombard, Odier & Cie, invite young people to participate in the WCRC Youth Network's call for essays. The theme for the essays—Ecumenism from the Margins: Confessing a God of life in a world fallen among thieves.



TIMELINE:

Essays written in English of between 5,000 and 6,000 words are due by 15 December 2021.

FORMAT AND RULES:

- The essay will illustrate a familiarity with the Reformed tradition, theology, and ecumenism and demonstrate a grasp of the theme and work of the WCRC.
- Cash awards (of 600 and 300 euros respectively) and scholarships to the next Global Institute of Theology (Planned in 2022) will be granted to two selected essays.
- These two essays, as well as select others, will be published in a special edition of *Reformed World*.
- The essay will be submitted electronically in Word format to: reformed.world@wrcr.eu
- The essay will be accompanied by notes and a bibliography which clearly indicate sources quoted in the paper.
- Submissions are open to theological students or pastors 35 years of age or younger.
